It was launched in response to the heartbreaking terrorist attack in Pahalgam on April 22, where 26 innocent people lost their lives. On the night of **May 7–8, 2025**, India carried out precise and non-escalatory strikes on terror camps across the border. was named **Sindoor** — a symbol of dignity and marriage — to honour the women who lost their loved ones.
