From coral reefs to rainforests, students were transported into India's wild ecosystems and taught that nature is not something distant but deeply connected to our daily lives.

The speaker emphasised the emotional dimension of environmentalism, encouraging students to feel wonder, empathy, and respect for all life forms. His stories of frogs, elephants, mangroves, and mountaintops resonated deeply with students of all ages. Interactive segments and reflective moments made the session truly memorable and impactful, sparking discussions among students long after the event.
